Since 1987, NSGA has governed the biennial National Senior Games, the largest multi-sport championship event in the world for seniors. The Association is comprised of 53 independent Member Games that conduct qualifying competition events. The 2022 National Senior Games presented by Humana will take place May 10-23, 2022 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and surrounding communities. The Games will be home to a projected 10,000 athletes plus family members and visitors over the fourteen days of competition including Flame Arrival Celebration, the Celebration of Athletes and The Village.
